Ordinance NO. 2014 09

Class B liquor License Ordinance – 2014

The town Board of Beetown Township, Grant County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under 125.185(1) to adopt this ordinance

Once issued a Class B Liquor License, an establishment will be open for business to serve the general public a minimum of 6 hours per day for at least 10 days per calendar month.

If any establishment which has been issued a Class B Liquor license fails to be open to serve the general public for the minimum number of days per calendar month that liquor license will be revoked.

After revocation or surrender of a Class B liquor License, a new application must be completed and acted upon by the Town Board of Beetown Township.

The purpose of this ordinance is to make certain a Class B liquor license is not held in order to prevent someone with an honest desire to operate an establishment from being able to do so.

This ordinance Revokes and makes null and void any former ordnance(s) on this issue.
